

Grant Guidelines

Quality of Life Grants

Caregiver Respite

- Professional home care
- Personal Care Provider (cannot be resident of the home)
- House cleaning services
- Lawn and yard care removal

Cost of Care (Medications & Equipment)

- Medical Expenses & Co-pays
- Mobility/Communication
- Nutrition/Respiratory
- Emergency (generators)/Alert Devices

Home & Vehicle Modifications

- Building of ramps (materials & labor)
- Bathroom accessibility (materials & labor)
- Doorway accessibility (materials & labor)
- Grab bar accessibility (materials & labor)

Access to ALS Physician and/or Hospitalization

- Lodging for ALS clinic, physician and/or hospital (1room, 2-night limit)
- Incidentals for ALS clinic, physician and/or hospital (i.e., tolls, parking)

Year-Round Activities of Daily Living (ADL) Grant

Communication/Equipment

Acceptable

- Durable equipment and devices (including bathroom medical equipment)
- Portable ramps
- AFO braces/splints
- Tablet device for communication
- Computer software or apps for communication
- Augmentative communication & alert devices
- Adaptive switches, Eyegaze and access methods for tablets or computers
- Communication mounting system
- Emergency call system rentals or purchases

Not Acceptable

- Computer repairs
- Internet fees or phone bills
- Televisions/apple TV
- Virus protectors
- Computer tables/desks, device covers, screen protectors, or any type of device accessories
